Picture cards & word cards

Weather chart

What you'll need:

- a large copy of the weather chart
- lots of copies of picture cards on card
(their size should match the columns)
- adhesive (e.g. Blu Tack)

Step 1

Laminate the weather chart.

Step 2

Laminate the picture cards.

Step 3

Ask children to attach picture cards to describe the weather on each day of the week.

Step 4

Speak to the picture cards.

In years 3 & 4: Use data from the school's weather station to add temperature and wind speed.

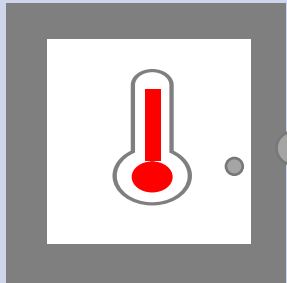
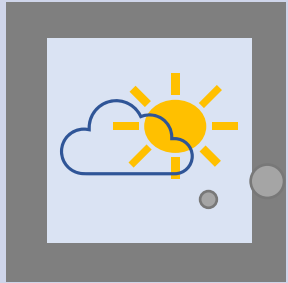

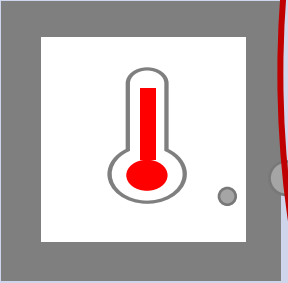
